Update

78% of Hazard Burnt Trees Down

The current number of hazard burnt trees removed by crews working in the Butte Fire area from both Public Right of Ways and Private Property has increased to **6,572**. Currently **12** cutting crews and **8** hauling crews are working on this project. Monitors remain present at all work sites.

Hauling crews are removing debris and logs that have been left by cutting crews and hauling to them to Wallace to be chipped and then transported to Chinese Camp to a Biomass Plant (Waste-to-Energy Plant).

Work continues on Doster, Hawver, Baker Riley, Worten, Whiskey Slide, Jesus Maria, Potteroff and Railroad Flat Roads. Hours of Operation are from 6:30am to 6pm Monday thru Saturday (weather permitting).
