### **MORE THAN 100 TREES FELL WITHIN CALAVERAS COUNTY DURING RECENT STORMS**

The past week storms have caused some severe damage to local roadways. There have been numerous mudslides and culvert failures. Also more than 100 trees have come down onto roads County-wide.

**Damages, Downed trees and Road Closures are as follows:**

#### Downed Trees

Arnold - 35

Dorrington - 25

Glencoe/Railroad Flat - 15

Jenny Lind/Valley Springs - 14

San Andreas/Mt Ranch - 15

#### Mudslides

Mt Ranch /Butte Fire Area- 38

**\*All roads are passable but people should drive consciously when driving thru these areas.**

#### Road Closures

**Murphys Drive in Blue Lake Springs**

**Snow Shoe Thomson in Snow Shoe Spring**

**Hawver Rd, in Mt. Ranch**

**Gwin Mine Rd in Paloma**

**Highway 26 West of Mokelumne Hill to Paloma Rd.**

Road Crews are out working 24/7 to clear roadways impacted by the storms. Crews cannot work on 10-12 roads in the Arnold/Dorrington areas due to downed powerlines. PG&E is working to clear those lines. Once that work has been completed County Road Crews will be able to move trees out of the roadway and plow the roads.
